SHIRLEY ANN JACKSON



For more than 30 years, Dr. Shirley Ann Jackson has charted new pathways for women in science. Her career has encompassed senior positions in higher education, industry and government, and has been marked with a succession of historic firsts. In 1973, she became the first African-American woman to receive a doctorate from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. In 1995, she became the first African-American woman named chair of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. In 1999, she became the first African-American woman to lead a national research university, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, N.Y., the nation's oldest technological university.

Born in Washington, D.C., in 1946, Jackson credits her parents for encouraging her to persevere against the era's prevalent racism and sexism and pursue her interests in science and math. The hostility she encountered, first as a student in Washington-area schools and then while pursuing a bachelor's degree in physics and a doctoral degree in theoretical physics at MIT, steeled her resolve and shaped her belief in "affirmative opportunity" for all students to pursue their dreams.

Today, Jackson is internationally respected as a theoretical physicist, an astute administrator, and as a courageous, insightful educator whose passion is encouraging young women, and all young people, to enter the world of science. In recognition of her achievements, she has been elected a member of numerous prestigious professional societies, including the National Academy of Sciences, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and the American Physical Society. In 2001, she became the first African-American woman elected to the National Academy of Engineering – another great "first" in a long and illustrious career.

Jackson is today's commencement speaker and will receive an honorary doctorate of science degree.

DAN K. MCNEILL



As commanding officer of U.S. military forces in Afghanistan, Lt. Gen. Dan K. McNeill led nearly 7,000 American men and women in uniform and coordinated the efforts of thousands of coalition forces from Canada, Britain and other countries. His appointment to this high post, in June 2002, marked the first time a single officer stationed in the region had been entrusted with authority to oversee most aspects of the fight against terrorism.

A North Carolina native, McNeill earned a bachelor of science degree in wood science and technology from NC State in 1968 and was commissioned as a 2nd lieutenant in the U.S. Army (Infantry). During his distinguished career as an army officer, he has commanded units at the company, battalion, brigade, division and corps levels. Most recently, he has commanded the 82nd Airborne Division and later the 18th Airborne Corps at Fort Bragg. Under his leadership, in 2000 Fort Bragg won recognition as one of the two top army posts in the nation.

McNeill's overseas tours have included Vietnam, Korea, Italy, Saudi Arabia and Iraq, and he has served his nation in operations Just Cause, Desert Shield, Desert Storm and Uphold Democracy. He has been awarded many of the military's highest honors, including the Distinguished Service Medal, Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal, Defense Superior Service Medal, Expert Infantry Badge and Master Parachutist Badge with bronze combat star. NC State has previously honored McNeill as the recipient of the 2001 Distinguished Alumni Award of the College of Natural Resources.

Today, McNeill will receive an honorary doctorate of humane letters degree.

JOHN P. SALL



As co-founder and executive vice president of SAS Institute, the world's largest privately held software company, John P. Sall has had an immeasurable impact – not only on the growth of SAS Institute, but on the growth of technology-enabled business, research and development worldwide.

To understand the scope of Sall's achievement, one must understand SAS itself. The SAS Project began in NC State's Department of Statistics in the early 1970s, and it quickly became evident that the resulting software would revolutionize statistical analysis. SAS Institute was spun off as a private company in 1976. Today, it is the world leader in business-intelligence software and services, serving more than 39,000 users at businesses, government and universities in 117 countries. At the center of it all is Sall. A gifted programmer with the uncanny skill to write virtually bug-free programs at amazing speed, he has designed and developed many of SAS' most significant analytical procedures, including JMP, a graphically oriented statistical package developed initially for Macintosh computers. He now leads the JMP product team and is responsible for the SAS InSchool division.

Sall's contributions to science, technology and education extend beyond the computer lab. He has held positions of leadership in the American Statistical Association's Statistical Computing section, and for eight years has served on the NC State College of Physical and Mathematical Sciences Foundation Board of Directors. He earned a bachelor's degree in history from Beloit College, a master's degree in economics from Northern Illinois University, and has studied graduate-level statistics at NC State.

Today, Sall will receive an honorary doctorate of sciences degree.

E. TRAVIS YORK



Growing up outside Mentone, Ala., during the 1920s and 1930s, Dr. E. Travis York witnessed the devastating effects of the Great Depression. The poverty and hunger he saw – along with the courage and ingenuity of those determined to make things better – shaped his values and strengthened his convictions in the power of education to change lives, and the power of science to help solve the world's problems.

Today, after a career spanning more than 50 years, York is admired worldwide as an innovative educator, a tireless humanitarian and an effective advocate for the use of international agricultural development as a weapon against hunger and malnutrition. He has served as an advisor to six U.S. presidents; had led presidential missions to Central America, the Caribbean, Egypt and Liberia; and has been a consultant to the U.S. State Department, the United Nations and foreign governments. In recognition of his work, in 1994 he received Rotary International's "Service Above Self Award" – the highest honor bestowed by the worldwide organization – and in 2001 was named the International Scientist of the Year.

York began his career at NC State, where he served as a faculty member and department head in agronomy from 1949 to 1956. After posts at Auburn University's Cooperative Extension Service and the USDA's Federal Extension Service, he joined the faculty at the University of Florida in 1963. In 1975, he was named chancellor of the State University System of Florida, a post he held with distinction until 1980, when he was named Chancellor Emeritus and Distinguished Service Professor Emeritus. He holds a bachelor's degree in agricultural sciences and a master's degree in soil science from Auburn University, and a doctoral degree in soil science from Cornell University.

Today, York will receive an honorary doctorate of sciences degree.

ACADEMIC COSTUME

Academic gowns represent a tradition handed down from the universities of the Middle Ages. These institutions were founded by the Church; the students, being clerics, were obliged to wear the prescribed gowns at all times. Round caps later became square mortarboards; the hoods, originally cowls attached to the gowns, could be slipped over the head for warmth.

Many European universities have distinctive caps and gowns which are different from those commonly used in this country. Some of the gowns are of bright colors and some are embellished with fur. A number of these may be noted in the procession.

The usual color for academic gowns in the United States is black. The bachelor's gown is worn closed, the master's and doctor's may be worn open or closed. The shape of the sleeve is the distinguishing mark of the gown: bachelor—long pointed sleeves; master—oblong, square cut in the back with an arc cut away in front; doctor—bell shaped.

Caps are black. The tassels for the Ph.D. degree are gold and those for other graduate and professional degrees may be of the color corresponding to the trimmings on the hoods.

Of all the components of the academic costume, the hood bears the heaviest burden. The hood must make clear the level of the degree, the faculty in which it was given, and the institution awarded it. The level of the degree is shown by the size of the hood, the width of the velvet trimming, and in the case of doctors, by the shape. The bachelor's master's and doctor's hoods are three feet, three and one-half feet, and four feet long, respectively. The velvet trimming in the same order is two, three, and five inches and extends all around the hood on the exposed edge. This same trimming identifies the faculty in which the degree was awarded. For each faculty there is a corresponding color; so a glance at the trimming is all that is needed to identify the faculty. A partial list of the colors follows: Agriculture, maize; Architecture and Art, brown; Science, golden yellow; Economics, copper; Education, light blue; Engineering, orange; Forestry, russet; Physical Education, sage green; Religion, scarlet; Speech, silver gray; Veterinary Medicine, gray; Textiles, wine red. The following faculties have the same color—dark blue: Anthropology, History, Languages, Literature, Philosophy, Political Science, Sociology.
