Objectives

1. To establish and maintain a 4-H Club Camp in North Carolina for Negro youth.
2. To provide educational trips and tours for 4-H Club members based on leadership and project accomplishments.
3. To provide scholarships for deserving club members based on record of leadership and project accomplishments.
4. To provide educational materials, such as, appreciation plaques to be given to friends and supporters of 4-H Club work, radio transcriptions, 4-H Club pins, exhibit materials, 4-H caps and "T" shirts.
5. To supplement the 4-H Club program among Negro youth in North Carolina; to further develop the needed skills and techniques of rural youth in the art of farming and home-making; and to appeal to the citizens of North Carolina for support of such worthwhile activities among Negro 4-H youth as are described above.

Questions and Answers

1. What is the 4-H Club Foundation of North Carolina, Inc.?

Ans.: A non-profit and educational corporation composed of individuals interested in aiding and promoting 4-H Club work among Negroes in North Carolina.

2. How may contributions be made?

Ans.: Checks should be made to "The 4-H Club Foundations of North Carolina, Inc." Mail to the Secretary of 4-H Club Foundation of North Carolina, Inc., A. and T. College, Box 67, Greensboro, North Carolina.

3. Can my contributions be deductible from my income tax?

Ans.: Yes, all donations are deductible on Federal and State income tax returns.

4. How will the funds be used?

Ans.: To aid and promote such activities as are mentioned in the objectives.

5. What is the membership fee for 4-H and Y. M. W. Club members?

Ans.: One dollar per club member.

6. How may these contributions be made?

Ans.: Through your local 4-H Club Secretary.

7. Will the names of 4-H and Y.M.W. Clubs contributing be printed in the brochure?

Ans.: Yes, those clubs contributing 100 per cent or \$1.00 for every member in the club.

8. Where can I obtain additional information on the 4-H Club Foundation or additional copies of this pamphlet?

Ans.: The Secretary of the 4-H Club Foundation of North Carolina, Inc., A. and T. College, P. O. Box 67, Greensboro, North Carolina.

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE 4-H FOUNDATION OF
NORTH CAROLINA, INC.

This is to certify that we, the undersigned incorporators, do hereby associate ourselves into a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of North Carolina, and to that end do hereby set forth:

1. The name of the corporation is The 4-H Club Foundation of North Carolina, Inc.

2. The location of the principal office of the corporation is in the City of Greensboro, Guilford County, North Carolina, but it may have one or more branch offices and places of business at other places in the State of North Carolina.

3. The objects and purposes for which the corporation is formed are to aid and promote, by financial assistance and otherwise, all types of educational, recreational and research activities now undertaken or which hereafter may be undertaken by 4-H Clubs or other organizations for the promotion of agricultural advancement among young people, by whatever name such activities may be known, and to aid and promote any and all types of education and research in the general field of agriculture within the State of North Carolina.

4. In order to properly prosecute the objects and purposes hereinbefore set out, the corporation shall have full power to receive donations, bequests, and devices; to purchase, lease and otherwise acquire and hold and to sell, donate and otherwise dispose of all kinds of property, real, personal and mixed; to donate all or any part of the equipment, materials or other facilities incident to any such education, recreation or research; and generally to do any and all acts and things which may be deemed necessary or expedient for the development, expansion and extension of

education and research in agriculture in the State of North Carolina and the promotion of 4-H Club work and similar work in agriculture among young people in said State.

5. The corporation is a non-profit, charitable and educational corporation and has no capital stock, and its conditions for membership are as follows: that members shall include the original members whose names are attached thereto and such persons, firms and corporations as shall meet the terms and conditions for membership as prescribed from time to time by the By-Laws of the corporation.

6. The management of the corporation and of its properties shall be vested in a Board of Directors which shall have full power and authority from time to time, without the assent or vote of the members, to make, alter, amend and rescind the By-Laws of the corporation; to make rules and regulations prescribing the terms and conditions for membership in the corporation, and to sell, donate or otherwise dispose of any and all of the property of this corporation, real, personal or mixed, in furtherance of any of the objects and purpose for which the corporation is formed. The number of Directors of the corporation shall be provided for and determined by the By-Laws of the corporation.

7. The period of existence of the corporation is unlimited.

8. No Director of the corporation shall receive any compensation whatever for or in connection with his services as such Director or as an officer of the corporation.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF 4-H CLUB ACTIVITIES AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

There is a total of 787 4-H and Y. M. W. Clubs organized for Negro boys and girls with a total enrollment of 46,582 club members. These club members are assisted by 4,770 voluntary local leaders. This represents 28,685 farm and non-farm homes in 50 counties. As a requirement for 4-H Club membership, each boy and girl must conduct a farm or home project covering some of the activities and enterprises that fit into the farm and home plan of the individual family. Last year 34,480 of these club members carried such projects which included poultry, corn production, home gardens, dairying, home beautification, food preparation, food conservation, health and first aid, etc.

Four-H work helps develop specific skills of boys and girls, and this is done through judging teams, demonstration teams, music appreciation, recreation, etc., in terms of community development. Last year 20,000 club members participated in fire and accident prevention; 23,000 carried health projects, and approximately 22,000 had health examinations as a part of their 4-H Club program. Four-H Club members, as a means of developing leadership, participate in the State Camping Program, attend State 4-H Short Course at A. and T. College, and they are represented in the Regional 4-H Camp for 4-H Club members in the Southeastern States.
