The Camp

The New Farmers of America Camp is located in Onslow County, near Swansboro, North Carolina, at Hammocks Beach. It's directly on the banks of Queen's Creek, a little bit more than a mile from the Atlantic Ocean. It was established in 1953 on property made available for this purpose by Dr. William Sharp. A 4,500 acre tract of land is under the direct control of Hammocks Beach Corporation and a Board of Directors.

The camp itself is under the management of the New Farmers of America of North Carolina, with headquarters at A. and T. College, Greensboro, N. C.

Facilities are available for housing and feeding 150 campers. Equipment and buildings are constructed to meet the standards of the American Camping Association.

The camp is operated under efficient management and well trained camp counselors for the months of June, July and August. One of these months is used exclusively by NFA members. Provisions are made whereby other campers and youth organizations may use the facilities.

The staff is well qualified to render the type of program most helpful to campers. Senior counselors are teachers; Junior counselors are competent, experienced campers in camp activities.

Every effort is made to keep the cost at a minimum fee.

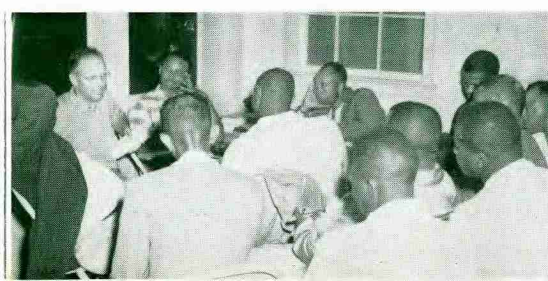
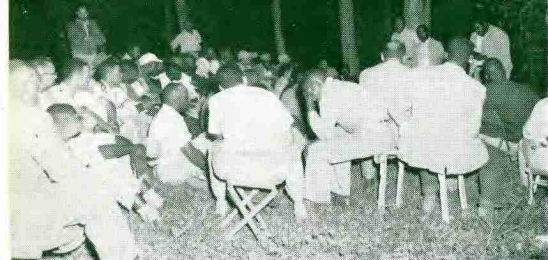
