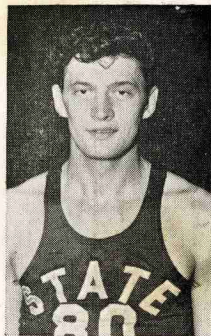
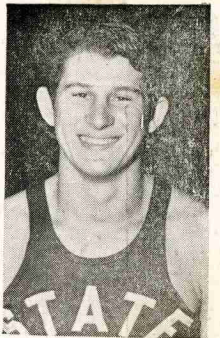
Bob Perich is a two year letterman on the Loyola team and is one of the better players on the squad. He did not compete last season and his return to the cage wars will help the Lions considerably.

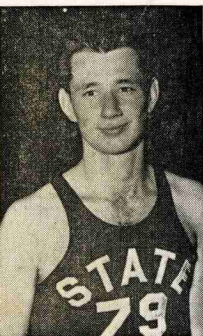
Mitch L'Heureux plays both forward and guard on the Loyola team and has won three varsity letters. 6'1" tall, steady player.



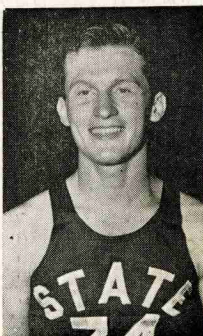

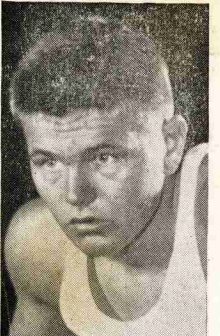
