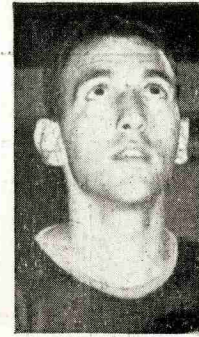


**Richard L. Dickey**, N. C. State's All-America forward is playing his last, and what may well be his best of four outstanding years of basketball. Dickey has scored a total of 1,184 points during three seasons of play. "Dick" stands 6-1 and weighs 180 pounds. His home town is Alexandria, Ind.

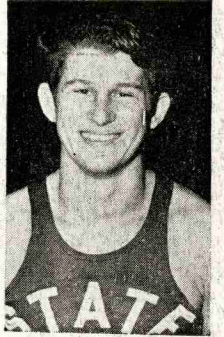


Co-Captain **Sumner (Tex) Tilson** is Virginia Tech's top scorer. In Tech's first 13 contests he had racked up 273 points to keep his average above 20 points per game. He was ranked as the nation's fifth top scorer in statistics released for all games through Jan. 14. Tex is a big man at six-feet, six-inches and does yeoman service off the backboards. His hands are used excellently to tap in rebounds and this method has been one of his most effective scoring weapons this year. Tex is also a good set-shot and can hook either to the left or right. He's wearing No. 45 and starts at center for Tech.

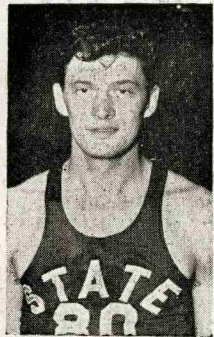
## V. P. I. Techs



Guard **Ted Bacalis** of V.P.I. is the other half of Tech's co-captain team. He is a deadly set-shot and moves the ball well from his backline position. Although standing just six-feet, Bacalis is a great rebound man. His excellent timing off the floor enables him to outguess the opposition on many rebounds. Bacalis is a "feeder" to Tilson and is responsible in a great measure for numerous assists on baskets credited to the Tech center. As a competitor there are few better men in the Southern Conference than Bacalis. He's wearing No. 25 and gets the nod at the starting guard slot for Tech tonight.



**Sam Ranzino**, the "sharpest shot in college basketball" was last season's high point maker with 381. Sam is a Junior, studies Industrial Recreation, and wants to play pro ball after the 1951 season. He is six feet one inch tall, weighs close to 200 pounds, and is from Gary, Ind.



**Paul Horvath**, six foot seven inch, 205-pound Junior from Chicago is a center and scored 301 points last season. Paul is studying Industrial Recreation, is a member of the honor society of 30 & 3. He is married and has a small daughter.

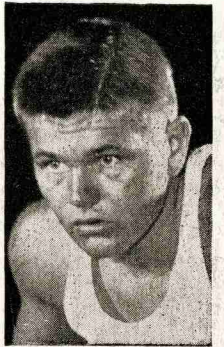

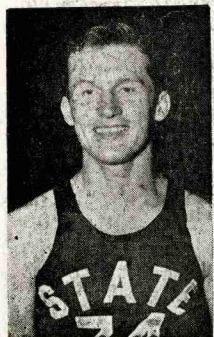
