

He was ranked as the nation's fifth top scorer in sta-tistics released for all games through Jan. 14. Tex is a big man at six-feet, six-inches and does yeoman service off the backboards. His hands are used excellently to tap in rebounds and this method has been one of his most effective scoring weapons this year. Tex is also a good set-shot and can hook either to the left or right. He's wearing No. 45 and starts at center for Tech.
