




Guard Dave Gotkin, New York City, N. Y. 1955 Captain

Captain of the 1955 team is Dave Gotkin, a brilliant outside shooter, who is showing the way in early practice with his driving lay-ups. Gotkin looks much improved over last year and likely will be used in a starting role. Last season Gotkin averaged 8.4 points per game, dropping down from his 13 point average as a sophomore, but indications point to Gotkin's scoring ability increasing this year. He led both Red and White teams with 34 points in the off-season practice game and in exhibition play this year has improved tremendously. Dave will be playing his fourth varsity season for the Wolfpack and was honored by his teammates by being named captain this year. Has a tremendous desire and is a fine floor leader. Dave's steading influence is one of his finest attributes and he's the quarterback of the Wolfpack offense, Gotkin was named All-City at Thomas Jefferson High before coming to State and has lived up to the advance predictions that he would become an outstanding college performer. Enrolled in Rural and Industrial Recreation and is a fine student. Dave is married to his high school sweetheart. He is the son of Joseph Gotkin, 678 New Jersey Avenue, Brooklyn, N. Y.


