#### 1960-61 SWIMMING

Highly optimistic! That's the swimming outlook for North Carolina State during the 1960-61 season.

"We will definitely have our best squad in five years, and could very likely have one of the outstanding teams in the South," commented swimming coach Willis Casey, in a turn-about for a coach.

All this is said, even though the Wolfpack does not have a senior on the squad. Some individual standouts, however, are the main causes of optimism by Casey and the State College following.

Peter Fogarasy, a Hungarian refugee who came to the United States in 1957 and who is now a sophomore, is one of the top breast-stroke men in the world. He won the National AAU 200 meter breast-stroke last summer, with a new American record of 2:38.8, but since he wasn't an American citizen he could not enter the Olympics in Rome. He should be a standout indoors this year.

Jim D'Anna and John Wilcox, two Florida boys from Clearwater and Tampa, respectively, are co-captains. D'Anna is the Atlantic Coast Conference champion in the 100-yard butterfly and Wilcox is the ACC record-holder in the 200-yard butterfly. Both boys are juniors.

Two other fine sophomores are Smokey Ellis, Miami, Fla., who established a new school record as a freshman in the fifty freestyle with a 22.3; and Ed Spencer, a 55 second flyer, who turned in a 1:01.7 100-meter fly in the outdoor nationals.

North Carolina State's swimming team will dedicate its new 2,000 seat indoor swimming stadium in January and the Wolfpack is rebuilding toward a top position in intercollegiate swimming, which they held from 1953-58.

The Wolfpack will open its season this Saturday at 3:00 p.m., in the Frank Thompson Gym Pool, hosting Maryland, last year's Atlantic Coast Conference championship team. Maryland won the ACC title meet, and handed the Casey swimmers their only loss in a dual meet. With the improved Wolfpack on the upgrade again, this Maryland meet should be one of the highlights of the season, locally.

North Carolina State will host the ACC championship meet this year in the new swimming stadium, Feb. 23, 24 and 25.
