

BIG FOUR BONANZA

Alumni basketball games generally turn out to be disappointments, attempts to recapture bygone eras that wind up as reminders that even the greatest of athletes grow old.

The first annual Big Four Alumni Basketball Bonanza, scheduled Saturday, June 17, in Raleigh's Reynolds Coliseum, may be a rare exception. It will feature past stars from UNC, N. C. State, Duke and Wake Forest in a fun-for-all doubleheader. Duke plays Wake in the 7 o'clock game, with State and Carolina alumns meeting in the nightcap.

Former stars from all the Big Four schools will be there, and the years they span touch the greatest eras of all their alma maters. Two national champions (UNC in 1957 and N. C. State in '74) will be well represented, as well as nine other teams that

reached the NCAA final four.

Duke's representation in the weekend, record. which includes festivities for all of the participants, comes from a group of players that can bridge the gap for old and young fans alike.

Art Heyman, the three-time All-American and National Player of the Year, will be on hand, along with Jeff Mullins, Jack Marin and Steve Vacendak. They stand for the Blue Devils' domination of the mid-1960's that included three NCAA final four teams. Heyman and Mullins are still Duke's top two scorers with 1,984 and 1,888 points, respec-

But it will not be merely a walk down tively. memory lane, since many of the players can still play the game like they did in college. At least 10 men who now play professionally here or abroad will undoubtedly see most of the action, once the "old-timers" have given out. Included are Tate Armstrong of Duke and the Chicago Bulls, NBA Rookie of the Year Walter Davis of UNC and the Phoenix Suns, Bob McAdoo of Carolina and the NY Knicks, Kenny Carr of State and the LA Lakers and Jerry Schellenberg of Wake, who averaged almost 30 points a game last season playing in France.

Unlike most all-star games, the doubleheader should contain some poignant memories and some prolific performances. Veteran ACC official Lou Bello, who will supervise the referees, will surely provide some of both. It was in the same Reynolds Coliseum that Bello was working a game between Bones McKinney (Wake Forest) and Everett Case (State). Upset with Bello's officiating, coach McKinney mockingly asked him the score at a time out. "Don't worry, Bones!" Bello bellowed. "We got ya by 10...
