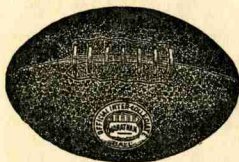

After completing his education, Mr. Miller spent three seasons in professional baseball.

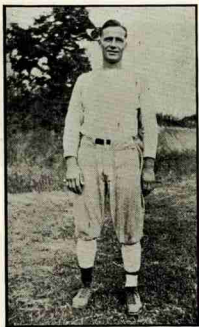
