A YEAR ago John P. (Little Clipper) Smith was football coach and athletic director at Duquesne University.

Having made many friends while coaching at State and having accomplished such impossible things at Duquesne as beating mighty Pittsburgh, it seemed a natural for State to sign the Dukes for today's Armistice Day game here in Riddick Stadium.

But late in the winter Clipper resigned and the States were greatly concerned about their newly-signed opponent. Further bad news came along in the form of flunk slips that were handed to nine varsity men. Ten more graduated. It looked like a bad deal for the States.

It has turned out to be anything but that, what with Clipper's successor, Buff Donelli, presenting today one of the few undefeated—united teams in this land of ours. His sophomores have upset Pittsburgh, avenged defeats handed the varsity of a year ago and the year before that by Texas Tech and evened up with Marquette for the beating of 1937, in addition to rolling over Illinois Wesleyan, Waynesburg and Manhattan.

So well have Donelli's Duquesnes done that already State has signed a contract with them for a game in Pittsburgh in 1940.

Two weeks from today the game that has come to be looked on as one of the best in North Carolina will be played on this field, between State and Duke.

This will be the last home appearance for State and the last of the year for Duke.

Next week, State goes to Greenville, S. C., to try to snap that streak of two consecutive ties with Furman University. The week after the Furman game, State plays University of Miami, in Miami, Fla., in the season's finale.

DUQUESNE'S MAN OF THE HOUR

Nobody knows how it came about, but everyone calls him Buff. He is one of Duquesne University's grid immortals . . . and on top of that he owns an international soccer football reputation . . . played for Uncle Sam in the International Soccer Games in Rome in 1934 . . . and scored all the goals made by the American Team in the entire meet. His appointment to the positions he now holds on the Hilltop climaxes a 13-year rise through Duquesne's athletic ranks . . . Entering Duquesne in the fall of 1926, he played center on the grid team his first season . . . came Elmer Layden to the Dukes in 1927 and Buff was shifted to a backfield post . . . played brilliantly behind the line for the next three years . . . first at right halfback . . . and later at fullback. The Dukes adopted the freshman rule in 1930 and Buff became the first frosh coach of football and basketball . . . In 1936 he handed the football voungsters over to former team-mate Lou Skender and moved up to the assistant varsity coaching spot under John P. (Little Clipper) Smith . . . the follow-ing season he transferred the freshman basketeers to Skender after piling up a record of 52 consecutive wins before meeting defeat . . . March, 1939, saw him swept into the Number One athletic post as head of his Alma Mater's first all-Duquesne athletic staff.

One of the youngest head men in the country, Buff at 32 years of age faces a tough job . . . 10 of last year's varsity were graduated in June . . another nine men departed from the campus, mainly because of their inability to round the scholastic course in par figures. Thirteen the current campaign . . plus 18 freshmen from last year's unbeaten yearling combination . . . A very tough spot for a young coach to find himself. However, Donelli is a tireless worker, a great leader, and an inspiring teacher . . . his boys are catching the fever . . and, though young and inexperienced, the Dukes aren't easy . . for anyone.

Buff leans toward the Rockne style of play ... but has seasoned it with a few ideas of his own....

Holds the Bachelor of Science in Economics and the Master of Business Administration degrees . . , has had to curtail his teaching schedule to one class in economics because of other duties. Became a Benedict in 1936 . . . and thinks his two-year-old son, Richard, is the best halfback prospect in the country . . if son Dickle ever calls them on the field for the Dukes, Hilltop followers will cheer if the lad is half as good as his dad.

Likes to fish and play tennis . . . right now he's the tennis champ of the Hilltop administrative staff. Plays golf, too, but has a pet peeve against the guy who designed the fairways so small and the outer regions so big.
