

Hardest running back ever to wear State uniform and can pass and kick when necessary. Averaged nearly 20 yards on each punt return last year and scored three touchdowns. Great high school record, named All-State (New Jersey) All-Metropolitan (Kearny) and All-County. Studying Rural and Industrial Recreation. Twenty years old. Will play left half in split-T.
