# ADULT LIFELONG STUDENT ORGANIZATION CONSTITUTION

## Article I. Name and Purpose

Section 1. This organization shall be known as Adult Lifelong Student Organization (ALSO).

Section 2. The purpose of this organization shall be to: provide orientation and non-academic advising services to new Lifelong Education (LLE) students; to represent LLE students on the Student Senate, Union Activities Board, program committees and before the University administration; to advise regarding allocation of Special Student fees; and to assist in developing other special programs, services, and communiques for LLE students as needed.

## Article II. Membership

Section 1. Membership shall be open to all LLE students who are interested in the concerns of adult, part-time students.

#### Article III. Officers

Section 1. The officers will be President, Vice-President and Secretary/
Treasurer.

Section 2. The officers shall be elected during the fall semester by the organization members to serve a term of one year. If offices are vacated after one semester, elections may be held to fill vacancies for the remaining term.

Section 3. In the event there are no officers available to convene the fall semester election meeting, volunteers from the LLE student body will be acceptable to serve as officers for a minimum term of one year.

#### Article IV. Dues

Section 1. No dues shall be assessed.

## Article V. Amending the Constitution and By-laws

Section 1. Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the organization in writing and be voted on at the end of the meeting. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Section 2. All amendments to this constitution or by-laws shall be subject to the approval of the Student Government.

Section 3. Any article of this constitution or part thereof that is in direct violation of the Student Government and declared unconstitutional by the President of Student Government. Any differences of opinion between the organization and President of the Student Government shall be brought before the Legislature, whose decision shall be final.

Article VI. Meetings

Section 1. The organization shall meet each semester as determined by the organization's membership.

Article VII. Committees

Section 1. The organization shall make provisions for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committee when needed.
