

Agape Asian Fellowship Constitution for 1997-1998

Name and Purpose: Agape Asian Fellowship (AAF)

- To lead others to a personal faith in Christ as Lord and Savior.
- To help Christians grow toward maturity as disciples of Christ through the study of the Bible, through prayer, and through Christian fellowship.

Membership: Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students in NC State University who are interested in having bible studies, prayer, and fellowship. There are no dues needed for membership. Regular attendance is all needed for membership.

Officers: The elected officers shall be selected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning Fall of 1997 until Fall of 1998.

Dues: Not Required.

Amending the Constitution and By-Laws: Amending the constitution or bylaws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted on until the next regularly scheduled meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members must be present and voting shall be required.

Meetings: The Club shall meet every week, unless specified.

Committees: The Club will appoint committees when needed and make provisions for any Standing Committee.
