CONSTITUTION of the Nest ARCHERY CLUB

ARTICLE I.	Name
Section 1.	This organization shall be known as the North Carolina State University Archery Club.
Section 2.	The purposes of this club shall be to promote the sport of Archery by providing a safe and efficient place to learn and practice.
ARTICLE II.	Membership
Section 1.	Membership shall be open but limited to all currently enrolled students, graduate students, and faculty.
Section 2.	Each member must have signed all waivers, releases, insurance forms or other forms as may be required by the University or club regulations, prior to participation in archery club events.
Section 3.	There will be no selective procedure for prospective members. Any student who

Section 3. There will be no selective procedure for prospective members. Any student who meets the requirements as set forth in Section 1 of this article, and is willing to contribute to the operation of the club, will be accepted as a member. No prospective member will be refused membership for the inability to pay dues.

ARTICLE III. Officers

- Section 1. Each officer must be a member of the club.
- Section 2. Officers and their elections:
 - The officers of this club shall consist of a president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, and faculty advisor.
 - b) The officers will be elected during the month of April by open nomination and secret ballot.
 - c) Each officer shall serve a term of one academic year or until their successors have been elected.
 - Officers may succeed themselves for any number of terms if properly elected.
 - e) Officers may be removed from office by two thirds vote of all active members.

Section 3. Duties of the officers:

- a) The president: shall preside over all meetings of the club; shall perform other such duties as may be prescribed by these bylaws or assigned to him by the club; shall be a member <u>ex officio</u> of all comities; and shall coordinate the work of all the officers and comities of the club in order that the purposes may be promoted.
- b) The vice-president: shall act as an aide to the president and shall perform the duties of the president in the absence or inability of that officer to act.
- c) The secretary: shall record all minutes of all meetings of the club; shall have a current copy of the by-laws; shall maintain a membership roster; shall perform other such duties as may be delegated to him/her.
- The treasurer: shall have custody of all the funds of the club; shall keep a full and accurate account of receipts and expenditures; and in accordance with

the budget adopted by the club, shall make disbursements as authorized by the president, executive committee, or club. Disbursements made in the form of checks or vouchers shall be signed by two persons, the treasurer and one other officer. The treasurer shall present a financial statement at every meeting of the club and at other times when requested by the executive committee and shall make a full report at the meeting at which the new officers officially assume their duties. The treasurer shall be responsible for the maintenance of such books of account and records as required.

 The faculty advisor: must approve of all club activities; will attend all business meetings; will function within the guidelines of the NCSU Sports program.

ARTICLE IV. Executive Committee

- Section 1. The Executive Committee will consist of the President, Vice-president, Treasurer, secretary, Faculty Advisor and three members elected out of the membership by two thirds majority of those present at the first club meeting of the academic year.
- Section 2. Powers: The committee will carry out the Constitution; will make recommendations on policy changes; will make recommendations on purchases and expenditures.

ARTICLE V. Dues

- Section 1. Each member shall pay dues to the club except as noted in Article II, section 3. Dues shall be determined by the Executive Committee and passed by a two thirds majority of total membership.
- Section 2. Dues will be collected at the start of each semester or upon joining if during the semester.
- ARTICLE VI. Meetings
- Section 1. The club shall meet regularly on a day decided upon by the members present at the first meeting of the semester.

ARTICLE VII. Committees

- Section 1. All committees shall be formed of members volunteering their services.
- Section 2. All committees shall appoint a chairperson or spokesperson to report committee's activities and/or progress at regular club meetings.

ARTICLE IIX Amending the constitution

- Section 1. Amendments to the constitution shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular club meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required for passage.
- Section 2. All Amendments to this constitution shall be subject to the approval of the Student Government.

Section 3. Any article to this constitution or part thereof that is in direct violation of Student Government by-laws or constitution shall be null and void and shall be declared unconstitutional by the president of the Student Government. Any differences in opinion between the club and the president of the student government shall be brought before the Student Legislature, whose decision will be final.
