

# **Art to Wear Fashion Show**

## **Article I**

### *Section 1*

This organization shall be known as the Art to Wear Fashion Show.

### *Section 2*

The purposes of this club shall be

- to offer NC State students an opportunity to learn and develop fashion design and conceptual art skills
- to provide a unique feature for NC State prospective students
- to create a fun atmosphere that promotes creativity and teamwork
- to create a fashion show every spring semester

## **Article II**

### *Section 1*

- Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in fashion and design.

### *Section 2*

- Membership will be recognized by attendance of  $\frac{1}{4}$  of spring meetings and participation in both committee activities and the show itself.

## **Article III**

### *Section 1*

- The elective officers for this club shall be the director, co-director(s), and specific committee heads.

### *Section 2*

- Officers are elected by club members after the fashion show at the post show meeting. Majority determines who wins the vote.
- Officers will serve a term of one year beginning after the election at the post show meeting in the spring.

## **Article IV**

### *Section 1*

- Dues for the club shall be in the form of attendance of all spring meetings and committee activities.
- There are no monetary dues.

**Article V**

*Section 1*

- Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

**Article VI**

*Section 1*

- The club shall meet bi-monthly in the fall and once or twice a month in the spring.

**Article VII**

*Section 1*

- The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.

**Article VIII**

*Section 1*

- Policies and procedures will be approved by a majority vote of the members present to vote.
