### **Article I**

#### **Name and Purpose**

##### Section 1

This organization shall be known as Black Finesse Modeling Troupe.

##### Section 2

The purpose of this organization shall be to create avenues in which students, particularly African Americans students, can express their talents through cultural expressions and promote a positive self-image of African beauty through modeling.

### **Article II**

#### **Membership**

##### Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in developing poise, confidence and elegance. In order for any member to be able to participate in a scheduled performance they must meet practice requirements consistently.

##### Section 2

Means of selecting members shall be by a screening process that determines the willingness of the person to learn the aspects of modeling, attend regularly scheduled meetings, and perform in designated fashion shows.

### **Article III**

#### **Officers**

##### Section 1

The elective officers of this organization shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, at least two Choreographers and Fashion Coordinators, Publicist, and Parliamentarian.

	Section 2	The officers shall be elected by the organization's member to serve a term of one year. Selections to be held in the Spring of each new year.
<b>Article IV</b>	<b>Dues</b> Section 1	Dues for this organization will be set at twelve dollars (\$12.00) per semester in order to ensure regular funding of publicity and purchases needed for office supplies, competitions, and shows.
<b>Article V</b>	<b>Amending the Constitution and by-laws</b>  Section 1	Amendments to the Constitution and by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required. Also those members who have not paid their dues will not be able to vote.
<b>Article VI</b>	<b>Meetings</b> Section 1	This organization shall meet as determined by the membership or whenever necessary for rehearsals of fashion shows, to ensure a quality performance and modeling cohesion.
	Section 2	This organization shall make provisions for any standing committee needed and /or for forming any special committees when needed.

A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required. Also those members who have not paid their dues will not be able to vote.
