

## **Constitution: Blitz for Hunger**

**February 4, 2008**

### **Article 1**

#### **Name and Purpose**

##### **Section 1**

This organization shall be known as the Blitz for Hunger.

##### **Section 2**

The purpose of this club shall be to organize students to spread awareness throughout NC State's campus and community about the issue of hunger experienced by low-income individuals in Wake County. We seek to bring students together through a campus-based and community food drive in March, as well as awareness events and coordination throughout the year. We will inspire classmates to give of their time and work for positive change in our community. This will be a club of like-minded individuals who value service and the opportunity to build leadership skills.

### **Article II**

#### **Membership**

##### **Section 1**

Membership shall be open to all enrolled students and faculty who desire to work to alleviate hunger and participate in the organization of the food drive and events.

##### **Section 2**

Membership is free and open to all who are interested. Volunteers are asked to register via a form on our website.

### **Articles III**

#### **Officers**

##### **Section 1**

The elective officers of this club shall be the president and the leadership committee, with the number of officers determined by the club for that academic year.

##### **Section 2**

The officers shall be elected by the club to serve for a term of one year beginning during the next academic year. Elections will be held at the end of the previous academic year, but officers may be added during the beginning of the current academic year at the discretion of the officers and members.

### **Article IV**

#### **Dues**

##### **Section 1**

Membership in the club is free of charge. This may be amended based on future needs by the officers and members.

## **Article V**

### **Amending the Constitution and by-laws**

#### **Section 1**

Amendments shall be presented to members of the club in writing and through email and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority vote of members and officers is required. Votes may be submitted through email if a member is not able to attend but still wishes to have a voice in the change.

## **Article VI**

### **Meetings**

#### **Section 1**

Meetings shall be held monthly during the fall semester and bi-weekly during the spring semester leading up to the food drive and awareness activities. Additional meetings may be announced and held if club members and officers deem them necessary.

## **Article VII**

### **Committees**

This club shall be organized into committees and teams to address different aspects of food drives and awareness events. Members will be put in teams under team leaders. Team leaders are members who are willing to act as the committee leader. There is no election or other process required for appointing team leaders.
