## Bylaws of the Campus Greens

## Name and Purpose

- 1. This organization shall be known as the Campus Greens.
- The purpose of this club shall be to promote and practice the political principles of the international Green movement.

## Membership

- Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in Green politics.
- 2. Members shall be selected by their signed adherence to the Ten Key Values of the international Green movement: Grassroots Democracy\* Social Justice\* Ecological Wisdom\* Nonviolence\* Decentralization\* Community-based Economics\* Feminism\* Respect for Diversity\* Personal & Global Responsibility \* Future Focus & Sustainability

### Officers

- Elected officers of the Campus Greens shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, and Assistant Secretary-Treasurer.
- Elected officers shall serve for a term of one academic year, at the end of which new elections shall be held.

#### Dues

- The amount of dues shall be determined by the Campus Greens membership at one of their first meetings.
- Assessments of the membership for special purposes may be proposed and decided upon by a simple majority of all those present and voting.

## Amending the Bylaws

1. The Bylaws may be amended by a 2/3 vote of members present and voting when at least half the registered membership is in attendance. Amendments should be presented to the entire membership at least two weeks prior to the vote.

# Meetings

1. Meeting times, places, and frequency shall be decided by the membership each semester. Responsibility for convening meetings shall be taken by the president, vice-president, secretary-treasurer, assistant secretary-treasurer, in that order.
