Constitution for Campus Relay 4 Life

Article I	Name and Purpose	
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Section 1 This organization shall be known as the Campus Relay for Life

The purposes of this club will be to host a Relay 4 Life event in which the campus is involved. The group will work together to have teams that will help raise money for cancer research, treatments, and any other needs to help the American Cancer Society and those suffering from cancer. It will also strive to further inform the student body of cancer and it's effects.

Article II Membership

Section 1 Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in helping to raise money for cancer, and participating in the Relay 4 Life event.

Section 2 Means of selection of members is open to anyone willing to volunteer their time to help.

Article III Officers

Section 1 The elective officers for this club shall be the chair committees and volunteer for their positions.

Section 2 The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning after each Relay event until the following Relay event is finished

Article IV Dues

Section 1 There shall be no dues to the club, though all donations are welcome.

Teams require dues to participate but not all members of the club need be on teams to help.

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member for the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 for the member present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1 The club shall meet the first and last Wednesday of each month for as long as school as in session. Additional meetings, or changes in the schedule

will be made as necessary.

Article VII Committees

Section 1 Committees shall include three co-chairs each focused on one of the following:

1) Cancer Information, Luminaries, and Survivors

2) Team Captains and Fundraising

3) Publicity and Logistics

There will also need to be chairs in charge of the following:

1) Accounting and Treasury

2) Recruiting, Fundraising, and Team Captains

3) Publicity, Campus Meetings, and News Letters

4) Entertainment, Logistics of the Event, Survivors, and Luminaries

5) Administration, Relating with the American Cancer Society and the Community
