Campus Y Constitution 2/5/08

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as the Campus Y.

Section 2

The purpose of this club shall be to provide service leadership opportunities to the students of North Carolina State University, through a variety of service projects that have an impact on the campus and the local community.

Article II Membership

Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in participating in the service opportunities determined by the club.

Section 2

Membership shall be approved through a registration process within the club. Membership shall be approved as long as current enrollment is proved

Article III Officers

Section 1

The elective officers for this club shall be the President, Vice President of Finance, Vice President of Communication, and Vice President of Service.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning in the Fall semester and concluding at the end of the Spring semester. Elections shall be held during the Spring semester.

Article IV Dues

Section 1

Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1

The club will meet twice a month, on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month, at 7:30pm. Meetings shall alternate between business meetings and networking opportunities.

Article VII Committees

Section 1

Committees shall be voted on and determined at the appropriate time by club members. Appointment to committees will be on a volunteer basis.
