

CONSTITUTION
The Chamber Singers of
North Carolina State University

Article I

1. This organization shall be known as The Chamber Singers.
2. The Chamber Singers shall serve the purpose of offering a group in which interested and qualified members of the NCSU community can learn and perform choral music. The repertoire will embody a broad range of choral literature, ranging from music of the Renaissance to twentieth century art songs.

Article II

1. Full membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who express an interest in performance of choral literature in an advanced mixed ensemble. Interested students should also possess a talent for singing and learning challenging vocal music.
2. Members of the organization shall be chosen exclusively through the discretion of the faculty advisor through an audition process. The size of the group shall be determined by the faculty advisor, and may change at his/her discretion. All interested students will be granted an audition as the need for members arises.

Article III

1. The elective officers of the club shall be a president, vice president, secretary, and librarian.
2. The officers shall be elected at the end of the spring semester by the club members to serve a term of one year beginning the first day of classes the following fall semester.

Article IV

1. The members of the organization will not be required to pay any dues for the privilege of membership. Each member will be expected to incur the expense of appropriate performance attire as defined by the faculty advisor.

Article V

1. Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI

1. The organization shall meet twice weekly each week of the fall and spring semesters. Meeting times are scheduled for 75 minute blocks from 4:05 until 5:20 on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. These meetings may be canceled only at the discretion of the advisor, and attendance is mandatory for all active members. Meeting times may be changed as resources dictate and at the discretion of the advisor.

Article VII

1. The organization shall form committees on a per-need basis. No standing committees shall be formed within the guidelines of this document, but may be formed at the discretion of the faculty advisor as he/she deems necessary.
