Constitution and By-Laws

ARTICLE I NAME AND PURPOSE

Section 1

The name of this organization shall be the Charisma Campus Ministry.

Section 2

The purpose of this group is develop a ministry where college students come to know Christ and to provide help and encouragement so that they can fulfill their God-designed destinies and change the world.

ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Section 1

Any student currently enrolled at North Carolina State University at Raleigh shall be eligible for membership.

Section 2

Membership will be given to those North Carolina State University students who attend group meetings.

ARTICLE III OFFICERS

Section 1

Officers of the Charisma Campus Ministry shall be the President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by club members to serve a term of one semester. Elections will be held on the last regular club meeting of each semester. Officers begin their term at the first regular meeting of the semester.

Section 3

The President shall perform all customary duties of the office, including arranging and running the meetings, registering the association, and reserving rooms for meetings.

Section 3

The Vice-President shall be responsible for assisting the President in his/her duties and serving as President in case of President's absence.

Section 4

The Secretary shall maintain updated official records, assist with association correspondence, and forward e-mail from other officers to members.

Section 5

The Treasurer shall keep financial records and accounts of all financial transactions, handle all receipts and expenditures, and make funding requests to appropriate student government bodies.

Section 6

All officers of the Charisma Campus Ministry are expected to maintain at least a 2.0 grade point average during their term in office. In addition, the officers are expected to avoid all forms of immorality, including (but not limited to) drinking alcohol, using illegal drugs, and sexual immorality.

ARTICLE IV AMENDING THE CONSTITUTION

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution of by-laws shall be presented to the members of the club in writing at a regular meeting. A majority of 2/3 of the members must be present and participate in the voting.

ARTICLE V MEETINGS

Section 1

The group will meet once per week during the semester as determined by the club membership each semester.

ARTICLE VI COMMITTEES

Section 1

Any special committee needed may be formed during the semester. Special elections for officers to head these committees may be held at any regular meeting of the semester.
