Colleges Against Cancer Constitution January 12, 2008

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as the Colleges Against Cancer

Section 2

The purpose of this club shall be to bring American Cancer Society programs and services to the N.C. State community through grassroots advocacy, prevention and early detection education, Relay For Life<sup>®</sup>, and activities honoring cancer survivors.

Article II Membership

Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in fighting the battle against cancer.

Section 2

Members are any and all students who volunteer their time and efforts to the organization.

Article III Officers

Section 1

The elective officers for this club shall be Advocacy Chair, Cancer Education Chair, Relay For Life Chair, and Survivorship Chair.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning in August and ending the following year in August.

Article IV Dues

Section 1

Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

## Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and reading at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1

The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.

Article VII Committees

Section 1

The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
