

Communication Disorders Research Club
Constitution

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1 This organization shall be known as the
Communication Disorders Research Club.

Section 2 The Purpose of this club shall be to conduct research
with the intent of further developing and
understanding various aspects in the field of
communication disorders.

Article II Membership

Section 1 Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled
students who are interested in the field of
communication disorders.

Article III Officers

Section 1 The elective officers for this club shall be one of
each of the following: president, vice president,
secretary and treasurer.

Section 2 The officers for this club shall be elected by the club
members to serve a term of one year, beginning at the
end of each school year.

Article Dues

Section 1 Dues for the club shall be in the form of special
assessments voted on by a majority of the club
members present voting and paid at the beginning of
each semester.

Article V Amending the
Constitution and by-laws

Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be
presented by the members of the club in writing and
read at a regular meeting, but shall not be voted upon
until the next regular meeting, and then after informing
each member for the proposed amendments. A majority
of 2/3 for the members present and voting shall be
recorded.
