Constitution

- Article I      Name and Purpose
- Section 1      This organization shall be known as the Critical Mass Bike Collective.
- Section 2      The purpose of this club is to promote bike commuting and biker's equal access to the roads in greater Raleigh.
- Article II      Membership
- Section 1      Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students, faculty and staff interested in joining.
- Section 2      Membership shall be approved for any student, faculty or staff wishing to join.
- Article III      Officers
- Section 1      The elective officers for this club shall be the Headset, the Cog, the Sprocket and the Pothole.
- Section 2      The officers shall be elected for a term of one year, beginning in May.
- Article IV      Dues
- Section 1      Dues shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present when voting.
- Article V      Amending the Constitution and Bylaws
- Section 1      Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and the only after informing each member for the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 for the members present and voting shall be required.
- Article VI      Meetings
- Section 1      The club shall meet as determined by the membership each semester.
- Article VII      Committees
- Section 1      Special committees shall be formed to head projects when deemed necessary by a majority of the members present at a regular meeting.
