Constitution of The Cross- Country/ Track Club of NCSU

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1 This organization shall be known as the Cross-

Country/ Track Club of NCSU.

Section 2 This club's purpose is to provide university

students with a group to run with and to provide the

opportunity to race.

Article II Membership

Section 1 Membership shall be opened to all regularly enrolled

students and faculty who are interested in running with other people. Membership will be granted upon completion of all

required forms and the payment of dues.

Section 2 Participation and Attendance shall be recorded at all

informational meetings and races. These meetings and races are official club eyents. Those who have been granted membership and have been present for at least two official club eyents are to be considered "active" members.

Section 3 All individuals must comply with the university

requirements as well as the club sports program requirements concerning health insurance and Club

Participant Waiver Forms.

Section 4 All members will agree to abide by this constitution and

university rules which apply to campus organizations.

Section 5 Any member found guilty of un-sportsmanlike conduct may

be voted out of the club by a majority vote of at least half of the active club members at a regular club meeting, and with the approval of the club sports assistant director and have

their membership cancelled.

Article III Officers

Section 1 The elected officers of this club shall be President, Vice

President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Any additional officer or chairman may be added by the active members of the

club through a majority vote.

Section 2 Election of the officers will be held during the first week of

April, during spring semester. All active members are

eligible for election.

Section 3 The duties of the President shall include the following:

presiding over meetings, organizing and scheduling meetings, submission of all forms and waivers required,

maintaining a relationship with the Club Sports Assistant

director, and delegating duties to other officers.

Section 4 The duties of the Vice- President shall include the following:

> Presiding at meetings and events in President's absence, contributing to official decisions, and assisting in any club

affairs.

Section 5 The duties of the treasurer shall include the following:

> maintaining a financial account of the club, managing income and financial expenses of club, contributing to official decisions, and assisting in any club affairs.

Section 6 The duties of the Secretary shall include the following: Attending meetings and taking the minutes, submitting

those minutes to the president, contributing to official

decisions, and assisting in any club affairs.

Article IV Amending the Constitution and By-Laws

Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be

presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular club meeting. It shall be considered and approved by the officers as a pertinent consideration. A two-thirds (2/3) majority vote by active club members and the approval of the Club Sports Assistant Director will be required for

ratification.

Article V **Meeting Requirements**

Section 1 The officers shall decide upon dates to hold monthly

informational meetings. These dates shall be decided upon

at the beginning of the semester.

Section 2 Practice times shall be at least three (3) times per week

> unless there is a holiday. The officers shall decide and agree upon a regular time and place to meet for practice.

Article VIII Club Activities

Section 1 Club activities shall include club meetings,

workshops, fund raising events, social events,

practices and meets.

Section 2 There will be a minimum of 2 business meetings per

semester.

Section 3 All club activities are subject to approval by the

faculty adviser and the club sports assistant director.

Article IX Rules

Section 1 The rules of participation shall follow the rules

adopted by the NCAA.

Section 2 These rules shall be modified by majority vote of at

least one half (1/2) of the active club members and approved by the club sports assistant director to conform the available participation surfaces.

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Constitution of The Track and Field Club of NCSU

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1 This organization shall be known as The Track and

Field Club of NCSU.

Section 2 This club shall provide and organized structure for

the participation in and the enjoyment of the sport of

track and field for the North Carolina State

University community.

Article II Membership

Section 1 Membership shall be opened to all regularly enrolled

students, staff, or faculty who are interested in the participation or contribution to the sport of track and field and are in good standing with the university. Membership shall be granted upon completion of all required forms and payment of

membership dues.

Section 2 All individuals must comply with the university

requirements as well as the club sports program requirements concerning health insurance, and Risks, Hazards, and Physical Stresses Forms.

Section 3 All members will agree to abide by this constitution

and university rules which apply to campus

organizations.

Section 4 Any member found guilty of unsportsman like

conduct may be voted out of the club by a majority vote of at least half of the active club members at a regular club meeting, and with the approval if the club sports assistant director shall have their

membership cancelled.

Article III Officers

Section 1 The elective officers of this club shall be the

President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary.
Section 2 The duties of the president shall include, presiding

over official meetings, organizing meetings, the submission of Risks, Hazards, and Physical Stresses Forms to the intramural recreation office, and reporting to the club sports assistant director.

Section 3 The duties of the Vice-President shall include.

presiding over official meetings in the absence of the President, and contribution to official decisions.

The duties of the Treasurer shall include, the Section 4

management of club funds and contribution to

official decisions.

The duties of the Secretary shall include, informing Section 5

the members of events, official correspondence and

contribution to official decisions.

The officers of this club shall be elected my majority Section 6

vote of at least one half of the active club members, to serve a term of one year, beginning the first week

of may each year.

Election of officers will be held during the first week Section 7

of April. All current active members in good academic standing are eligible for election.

Amending the Constitution and By-Laws Article V

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be Section 1

presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member f the proposed amendments. A two-thirds (2/3) majority vote and the approval of the club sports assistant director will be required for

ratification.

Article VI Meetings

The frequency and length of meetings will be Section 1

determined by the availability of playing surfaces and by member participation. A meeting of at least half the club members should occur at least once a

month.

Article VII Faculty Adviser

Section 1 The faculty adviser will be a member of the faculty

or staff of North Carolina State University and will be selected by the members of the club and approved

by the club sports assistant director.

The duties of the faculty adviser shall include the Section 2

attendance of at least three (3) business meetings of the club (preferably the first business meetings of the fall and spring semesters and the last meeting of the spring semester), approval of all club functions, the accompaniment of the club on outings whenever possible, and helping the club in making it's yearly

budget.
