Article I	Name and Purpose Section 1	This organization shall be known as Delta Epsilon Chi Division of DECA.
Article II	<u>Membership</u> Section 1	Membership will be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in business.
	Section 2	Active members shall be students in post-secondary programs of marketing, merchandising, management, and/or related fields. An active member must pay dues as established by the Delta Epsilon Chi Division, and may be declared eligible to hold a national office, to participate in national competitive events ort project, to serve as a national voting delegate or to otherwise represent his/her association in National DECA affairs as may be approved by his/her association.
Article III	Officers Section 1	The elective officers of this club shall be the president, the vice-president of programming, the vice-president of finance, and the vice-president of communication. The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year beginning May of each year.
Article IV	Dues Section 1	Dues for the club shall be 8.50 per semester – or- dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.
Article V	<u>Amending the Const</u> Section 1	itution and By-laws Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
