

Feminist Student Organization Constitution

Article I – Name and Purpose

- I. This organization shall be known as the Feminist Student Organization.
- II. Currently no affiliations
- III. The purpose of this club shall be to promote legal, political, social and economic change on our campus and in our society in order to achieve our goal, which is to eliminate sexism and end all oppression.

Article II – Membership

- I. Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students and faculty who are interested in feminist issues on campus and in the community.
- II. Membership in the club shall be approved by regularly attending meetings and events.

Article III – Officers

- I. The officers of this organization shall consist of:
 - a. President – schedule meetings and oversee events
 - b. Treasurer – in charge of finances
 - c. Secretary – will take notes and send e-mails
 - d. Vice-president – will help president
- II. There are currently no qualifications to hold office, other than attendance at meetings.
- III. Term of office shall be one year.
- IV. An officer is removed with a majority vote. Any member can request the removal of an officer, and it shall be discussed by all members.

Article IV – Dues

- I. Currently no dues for membership.

Article V – Amending the Constitution and By-laws

- I. The constitution may be amended by consensus vote of members at the meetings. Anyone can request amending the constitution.

Article VI- Meetings

- I. Regular meetings of this organization will be once a month and decided on at the previous meeting. The secretary will send out a reminder via listserv.
- II. There is no quorum limit, a limit will be set when needed.

Article VII – Committees

- I. The club shall make provisions for any standing committees needed when needed.
