| | Section 1 | The elective officers for this club shall be the President, Quartermaster, Treasurer, and Secretary. |
| | Section 2 | The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning in September of the Fall Semester. |
| Article IV | Dues | |
| | Section 1 | Yearly dues shall be \$10 from all members wishing to buy a T-shirt. |
| Article V | Amending the Constitution and By-laws | |
| | Section 1 | Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then |

only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 for the members present and voting shall be required.
