

The Constitution of the Fine Swine Society

Article I **Name & Purpose**

Section 1 This organization shall be known as the Fine Swine Society.

Section 2 The purpose of this club shall be to foster a community of barbecue connoisseurs through dining and to congregate as a group to discuss the finer points of a food integral to the culture of North Carolina.

Article II **Membership**

Section 1 Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in North Carolina barbecue.

Section 2 There is no formal selection process to gain membership in the club; all that is required is to attend a meeting.

Article III **Officers**

Section 1 The elective officers for this club shall be the President, Quartermaster, Treasurer, and Secretary.

Section 2 The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning in September of the Fall Semester.

Article IV **Dues**

Section 1 Yearly dues shall be \$10 from all members wishing to buy a T-shirt.

Article V **Amending the Constitution and By-laws**

Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then

only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 for the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI **Meetings**

Section 1

The club shall meet monthly or on an as-required basis.
