FOOD SCIENCE GRADUATE STUDENT ASSOCIATION

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I Name

The name of this organization shall be the Food Science Graduate Student Association.

ARTICLE II Objectives

The objectives of this organization shall be:

- To provide a forum for discussion of matters of importance to graduate students in Food Science.
- To disseminate information of interest or importance to graduate students in Food Science.

ARTICLE III Membership

All graduate students majoring in Food Science at North Carolina State University are members, regardless of fee-paying status.

ARTICLE IV Officers

The officers of the association shall be a Chairperson and a Vice-chairperson. Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or booldaws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

- Section 2 All amendments to this constitution or by laws shall be subject to the approval of the Student Government.
- Section 3 Any article of this constitution or part thereof that is in direct violation of the Student Government constitution or by-laws shall be null and void and declared unconstitutional by the President of Student Government. Any differences of opinion between the club and the President of Student Government shall be brought before the Legislature, whose decision shall be final.

Article VI By-Laws

Section 1 Election of Officers

Both the chairperson and the vice-chairperson shall be elected the month of April (May).

Section 2 Nomination of Candidates Nomination shall be accepted from the floor and prior to voting.

Section 3 Resignation or Removal of Officers An officer may resign by submitting his resignation to the association one month prior to the effective date. An officer may be removed by the motion of any member. Such a motion will require a two-thirds majority of the votes present for passage.

Section 4 Officer Vacancy

In the event of the resignation or removal of a chairman, the vacancy will be filled by the vice-chairperson and a new vice-chairperson shall be elected. In the event of the resignation or removal of the vice-chairperson, the vacancy shall be filled by election. Section 5 Duties of Officers

The chairperson shall be the representative to the Graduate Student Association. The vice-chairperson shall serve as an alternate representative to the Graduate Student Association.

Section 6 Meetings

Meetings shall be held at least once during each semester.

Section 7 Votes

Each member shall have one vote.

Section 8 Finances

The chairperson shall serve as treasurer. All expenditures shall require a simple majority of votes present for passage.
