| | Section 1 | Membership shall be given to all presidents of their respective |

| Article III | Officers | |
| THE COLUMN | Section 1 | The elective officers of this organization shall be the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer, and Secretary. |
| | Section 2 | Due to the fact the each chapter president may be in office at different times, officers of the Fraternity Court Presidents Board will be elected and replaced as necessary. |
| | Section 3 | The chairman must have been in office as president of his respective chapter for minimum 6 months before he/she is eligible for the Chairman office. |
| Article IV | Dues | |
| | Section 1 | Dues for the organization shall be \$75.00 per semester for each chapter. This will change to \$50.00 per semester after the borrowed money is paid back to IFC. |
| Article V | Amending the Constitution and By-laws | |
| | Section 1 | Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by the members of the organization in writing and read at a regular meeting, but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then after informing each member of the proposed amendment(s). Quorum is set at two-thirds of the members with a majority ruling. |
| Article VI | Meetings Section 1 | The organization will meet bi-weekly. These meetings will meet on opposite weeks of the North Carolina State Inter-Fraternity Council's regularly scheduled meetings. |
| Article VII | Committees Section 1 | The organization shall form any special committees when needed or will make provisions for any standing committees. |
