

# Fraternity Court Presidents Board

## Constitution

- Article I     Name & Purpose  
Section 1     This organization shall be know as the Fraternity Court Presidents Board.  
Section 2     The purpose of the organization will be to use self-governance to deal with tenant issues arising on Fraternity Court.
- Article II     Membership  
Section 1     Membership shall be given to all presidents of their respective Fraternity Court chapter.
- Article III    Officers  
Section 1     The elective officers of this organization shall be the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer, and Secretary.  
Section 2     Due to the fact the each chapter president may be in office at different times, officers of the Fraternity Court Presidents Board will be elected and replaced as necessary.  
Section 3     The chairman must have been in office as president of his respective chapter for minimum 6 months before he/she is eligible for the Chairman office.
- Article IV     Dues  
Section 1     Dues for the organization shall be \$75.00 per semester for each chapter. This will change to \$50.00 per semester after the borrowed money is paid back to IFC.
- Article V     Amending the Constitution and By-laws  
Section 1     Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by the members of the organization in writing and read at a regular meeting, but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then after informing each member of the proposed amendment(s). Quorum is set at two-thirds of the members with a majority ruling.
- Article VI     Meetings  
Section 1     The organization will meet bi-weekly. These meetings will meet on opposite weeks of the North Carolina State Inter-Fraternity Council's regularly scheduled meetings.
- Article VII    Committees  
Section 1     The organization shall form any special committees when needed or will make provisions for any standing committees.
