

Game Design and Development Club Constitution

Article I – Name and Purpose

- Section 1** This organization shall be known as the Game Design and Development Club.
- Section 2** The purpose of this club is for students who are interested in learning how to create video games using the skills gained in programming courses to get together and learn about the logic behind games and learn how to program them. The secondary purposes include meeting people with similar interests and reinforcing knowledge gained in class.

Article II – Membership

- Section 1** Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in learning how to design and develop games.
- Section 2** All students who are interested in learning the above mentioned skills shall be selected as members. There is no selection process; any one interested will become members

Article III – Officers

- Section 1** The officers of this organization must be full time students in good standing with N.C. State University. The officers shall consist of 2 people:
1. The President, who will run the meetings and teach others the general skills of game design and development. The President will also maintain the web site of the club.
 2. The Vice President, who shall assume the President's duties if he/she is absent.
- Section 2** The term of office shall be one year.
- Section 3** Provisions for removal of an officer can be initiated by any member of the organization after the officer to be removed has completed half of their term. The removal will require a 2/3 majority vote. There will not be any appeals. In such a situation, there will be an election for the open position.

Article IV – Dues

- Section 1** This organization will always be free for anyone who is interested. No dues will be collected.

Article V – Amending the Constitution and By-Laws

- Section 1** This constitution may be amended by a vote of $\frac{3}{4}$ majorities of the club members. Amendments shall be written by the member who proposes them and voted on for ratification at the meeting after the proposition.

Article VI – Meetings

- Section 1** Regular meetings of this organization shall be held biweekly. The President shall be responsible for notifying members of upcoming meetings via email and posting the meetings on the club web site.
- Section 2** A quorum shall consist of at least 50% of voting members present at any meeting. Regular club activities shall occur no matter how many people attend, but there may not be any voting or amendment proposition at a meeting with less than 50% of members present. At the meeting, the President will begin with a greeting and talk about current events. The members will then split up into groups and begin working. The President will be the authority in deciding questions of parliamentary procedure.

Article VII – Committees

- Section 1** The club shall make provisions for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
