Article I: Name and Purpose

This organization shall be known as The Golden Intellectual Honors Society. The purpose of this club shall be to facilitate an educational environment for an elite group of thinkers.

Article II: Membership

Membership shall be open to students with a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 and held in high regards in academic environment. The club officers will select a few choice persons from the pool of candidates.

Article III: Officers

Officers shall be individually appointed by the president, who has full discretion over the clubs appointments. The president will then be required to consult with their officers upon appointing committee chairs. All future presidents will be elected by popular vote.

Articles IV: Dues

Clubs shall be required to pay two dollars per semester.

Article V: Amending the Constitution

Amendments to the constitution at the beginning of each semester by no less than two thirds of the club officers.

Article VI: Meetings
