

## Herpetology Club

### Constitution

#### Article I

Section 1: This organization shall be known as the Herpetology Club.

Section 2: The purposes of this club will be to fund research to individual undergraduate students and graduate students, to support field trips, to assist herpetological studies, to provide education to the public, and to support and promote the North Carolina Herpetological Society.

#### Article II

Section 1: Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students, faculty, or staff of NCSU who are interested in herpetology or herpetoculture (student members may be from other schools).

Section 2: Membership will be accepted upon an interest in herpetology.

#### Article III

Section 1: The elected officers for this club shall be the President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and Historian. The president will be in charge of the club and help organize and run meetings. The vice president will aid the president and take on most of the same responsibilities. The treasurer will be in charge of all money associated with the club, including purchasing equipment and taking dues. The secretary will be in charge of recording information at meetings. The historian will be in charge of maintaining the website and collecting photos and information on the club's history and field trips.

Section 2: The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year.

#### Article IV

Section 1: Dues for the club shall be \$8.00 per semester (\$10.00 for non-NC State students).

#### Article V

Section 1: Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the present and voting shall be required.

#### Article VI

Section 1: The club shall meet as determined by the club members each semester.

#### Article VII

Section 1: The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming committees when needed.
