The Constitution of The Hip Hop Organization (H2O)

Name:

The name of this Organization shall be The HIP HOP ORGANIZATION, here afterward referred to as H2O.

Purpose:

It is the purpose of this organization to bring together those who have a love for the world of hip hop in an effort to push the positivity of the culture forward through the actions of the organization.

Gaining Membership

Membership will be open to all regularly enrolled students or any non-enrolled persons acquainted with a member of the organization who are interested in acquiring knowledge of and participating in the hip hop culture. To gain membership to the Hip Hop Organization a member must pay dues

Executive Officers:

Can only be held by a student currently enrolled at the University

President:

Shall be the head executive officer of H2O Shall preside over meetings Acts as H2O representative to community and University Call for Votes Takes Nomination and motions Has Power to table votes 1 meeting (except elections Shall maintain contact with all committee heads

Vice-President:

Shall take on any Presidential duties while the president is absent Acts as H2O representative to community and University Shall maintain contact committee heads Assumes office when any officer is unable to fulfill their obligations until the officer is replaced

Secretary

Takes minutes and emails them to members Acts as historian Prepares documents for meetings Composes agenda for meetings based on information for committee heads and other officers

Treasurer

Is responsible for all money Shall act as financial secretary for H2O Shall report upon request the financial status of the H2O Is responsible for all disbursements Shall update all accounts when officer changes occur

Committee Heads: Can be held by any member of H2O

Shall hold meetings as needed

Alerts Presidents, VP and Secretary of all divisions made at committee meetings Contact Secretary with information regarding the agenda for the meeting

Officers shall be elected by the organization members to serve a term of one year beginning the 1st week after the results of the organization elections are held in the spring semester.

Article 4 dues

Dues of the club shall be \$10 per year and if and only if the member is graduating in December \$5 for the semester.

Amending the Constitution

Amendments will be made by a 2/3 majority vote of active members. Voting should be announced one meeting in advance.

Meetings

The club shall meet every 2nd Sunday of the month at 6:00pm. This time is subject to change at any time during the year by a vote of 2/3 of the current members.

If a member misses 4 meetings without sufficient reasoning during a semester the person's membership will be revoked for the rest of the year.
