Constitution

- Article I Name & Purpose
Section 1 This organization shall be known as the History Club at North Carolina State University.
Section 2 The purposes of this club will be to further and enrich the study of history at North Carolina State University, not only for history majors but for all currently enrolled students. the Club shall encompass the entirety of historical study. In addition, the Club shall provide students with a chance to socialize and engage in intellectual discussion with fellow students and faculty members.
- Article II Membership
Section 1 Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in pursuing intellectual and social involvement in the area of History.
Section 2 Membership shall be conferred to members who pay their yearly dues.
- Article III Officers
Section 1 The elected officers of this club shall be the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Historian, Events Coordinator, and Publicity Coordinator.
Section 2 The officers shall be elected by the Club members to serve a term one year, beginning at the end of the Spring semester of one academic year and ending at the end of the next academic year.
- Article IV Dues
Section 1 Dues shall be in the amount of \$3 per semester to help fund the activities of the History Club at NCSU and its constituent members.
- Article V Amending the Constitution and By-Laws
Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the Club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
- Article VI Meetings
Section 1 The Club shall meet monthly during the academic year and on other designated occasions which the Club or its officers shall initiate.
- Article VII Committees
Section 1 The History Club at NCSU shall form standing committees upon the request of the members or officers of the Club.

Section 2 The officers shall be elected by the Club members to serve a term of one year, beginning at the end of the Spring semester of one academic year and ending at the end of the next academic year.
- Article IV Dues
Section 1 Dues shall be in the amount of \$3 per semester to help fund the activities of the History Club at NCSU and its constituent members.
- Article V Amending the Constitution and By-Laws
Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the Club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
- Article VI Meetings
Section 1 The Club shall meet monthly during the academic year and on other designated occasions which the Club or its officers shall initiate.
- Article VII Committees
Section 1 The History Club at NCSU shall form standing committees and special committees upon the request of the members or officers of the Club.

Constitution

Preamble We the people, in order to form a more perfect History Club, do ordain and establish this constitution.

Article I Name and Purpose

Section 1. This organization shall be known as the North Carolina State University History Club.

Section 2. The purpose of this club shall be the furthering of the knowledge of history by educationally stimulating and socially enjoyable means.

Article II Membership

Section 1. Membership shall be open to all students who are interested in the activities of the club.

Section 2. Means of selection of members. This club is open to all students who are interested in furthering the goals of the club.

Article III Officers

Section 1. The elective officers of this club shall be the President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary.

Section 2. The officers shall be elected each Spring by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning in September of a school year.

Section 3. In the event of the President being unable to fulfill his duties, the Vice-President shall be acting President until the membership, at the next regularly scheduled meeting, elects a new President.

Section 4. The offices of President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary are restricted to those members in good standing.

Article IV Dues

Section 1. Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting, not to exceed \$2.00 per semester.

Article V Amending the Constitution and By-laws

- Section 1. Amendments to the Constitution or By-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
- Section 2. All amendments to this Constitution or By-laws shall be subject to the approval of the Student Government.
- Section 3. Any article of this constitution or part thereof that is in direct violation of the Student Government Constitution or By-laws shall be null and void and declared unconstitutional by the President of Student Government. Any differences of opinion between the club and the President shall be brought before the Legislature, whose decision shall be final.

Article VI Meetings

- Section 1. The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.
- Section 2. An official meeting to conduct business much consist of a quorum of six (6) members present, including two (2) officers.
- Section 3. A meeting shall be considered official only if it has been publically announced by the secretary of the club.

Article VII Committees

- Section 1. The club shall make provisions for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.

Article VIII Advisor

- Section 1. The club members shall select the faculty advisor, by a majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting, at the same time that the elections for club officers are held.

Article IX Newsletter

- Section 1. The club shall publish a newsletter at intervals determined by the club members.

Historical Society Constitution

Article I. Name and Purpose

Section 1. This organization shall be known as the Historical Society.

Section 2. The purpose of this club shall be to give students the opportunity to broaden their historical awareness through extra-curricular activities.

Article II. Membership

Section 1. Membership shall be open to all students who are interested in going to historical places, listening to knowledgeable speakers and meeting other students.

Section 2. Means of selection of members. Second to the last meeting in the spring nominations shall be submitted and at the last meeting additional nominations and elections will take place.

Article III. Officers

Section 1. The elective officers of this club shall be the President, vice-president, Treasurer, and administrative officer.

Section 2. The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning with the fall semester (September.)

Article IV. Dues

Section 1. Dues can be ~~assess~~ assessed at an official meeting of the Historical Society by a $\frac{2}{3}$ majority vote.

Article V. Amending the Constitution and By-laws

Section 1. Amendments to the Constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, ~~and~~ then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of $\frac{2}{3}$ of the members present and voting shall be required.

Section 2. All amendments to this constitution or by-laws shall be subject to the approval of the Student Government.

Section 3. Any article of this constitution or part thereof that is in direct violation of the Student Government Constitution or By-laws shall be null and void and declared unconstitutional by the president of ~~st~~ Student Government. Any differences of opinion between the club and the President of the Student Government shall be brought before the Legislature, whose decision shall be final.

Section 1. The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
