Constitution

Article I	<u>Name & Purpose</u>	
	Section 1	This organization shall be known as the Men Interested in Iotas (M. I. I.).
	Section 2	The purpose of this organization shall be to serve as an affiliate of individuals interested in membership with Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc.
Article II	<u>Membership</u>	
	Section 1	Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled African American who are interested in Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc.
	Section 2	The selection for the members of this organization shall be based on a 2.5 minimum GPA.
Article III	<u>Officers</u>	
	Section 1	The elective officers of this organization shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
	Section 2	Officers shall be elected by the organization members to serve a term of one year, to begin on the first day of the Fall semester.
Article IV	<u>Dues</u>	
	Section 1	There are no required dues for this organization.
Article V	<u>Amending the Constitution and By-laws</u>	
	Section 1	Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
Article VI	<u>Meetings</u>	
	Section 1	Meetings for the organization shall be arranged by the President. All meetings will take place in a campus building.
Article VII	<u>Committees</u>	
	Section 1	Committees shall be arranged as seen fit by the officers.
