Article I	Name & Purpose Section 1 Section 2	This organization shall be known as the Men Interested in Iotas (M. I. I.). The purpose of this organization shall be to serve as an affiliate of individuals interested in membership with Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc.
Article II	Membership Section 1 Section 2	Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled African American who are interested in Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc. The selection for the members of this organization shall be based on a 2.5 minimum GPA.
Article III	Officers Selection 1 Selection 2	The elective officers of this organization shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Officers shall be elected by the organization members to serve a term of one year, to begin on the first day of the Fall semester.
Article IV	<u>Dues</u> Section 1	There are no required dues for this organization.
Article V	Amending the Constitu Section 1	Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
Article VI	Meetings Section 1	Meetings for the organization shall be arranged by the President. All meetings will take place in a campus building.
Article VII	Committees Section 1	Committees shall be arranged as seen fit by the officers.
