JAZZ ASSOCIATION

CONSTITUTION

Article I: Name and Purpose

- Section 1 This organization shall be known as the Jazz Association.
- Section 2 The purpose of this club shall be to promote live jazz music at NC State University.

Article II: Membership

- Section 1 Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in performing live jazz music.
- Section 2 Members will automatically be accepted after formal enrollment in the Jazz Ensemble course.

Article III: Officers

- Section 1 The elective officers shall be titled President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
- Section 2 The officers shall be selected by the director and the membership to serve a term of one year, beginning in August of each year.

Article IV: Dues

Section 1 There are no dues at present.

Article V: Amending the Constitution and By-Laws

Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until at the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member for the proposed amendments. A majority of two-thirds for the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI: Meetings

Section 1 The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.

Article VII: Committees

Section 1 The club shall make provisions for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
