Constitution

- Article I: Name & Purpose: This organization shall be known as the MACORG. The purpose of this club shall be the promotion of the best interest of master of accounting students.
- Article II: Membership: Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in accounting. Enrollment in Master of Accounting courses qualifies a student for membership.
- Article III: Officers: The elective officers of this club shall be: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning August 15.
- Article IV: Dues: Not applicable
- Article V: Amending the Constitution and By-Laws: Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
- Article VI: Meetings: The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.
- Article VII: Committees: The club shall make provisions for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
