MOD SQUAD

Constitution

Article I: Name and Purpose

Section 1: This organization shall be known as the MOD (March of Dimes) Squad.

Section 2: The purposes of this club shall be to educate college-age women about the benefits of a healthy lifestyle including preparing for pregnancy later in life. We seek to do this by starting a campus organization that addresses the problems of the lack of sufficient education, action, resources, and advocacy among college-age women.

Article II: Membership

Section 1: Membership shall be open to all students who agree to support the mission of the MOD Squad.

Section 2: All members shall be approved and anyone may attend meetings. Membership status is limited to dues-paying students.

Article III: Officers

Section 1: The executive officer positions of this club shall be the president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer, one of which will serve as a representative to the local March of Dimes chapter in Raleigh, NC. Other officer positions can be created if need is demonstrated. The creation of a position must be approved by the executive officers and members will have a simple majority vote on the person to hold this new position.

Section 2: Officers will be elected in April and their term will begin in August. An exception will be made in the occurrence of a graduating senior being replaced. When the senior graduates, the new officer's term will begin immediately instead of August.

Article IV: Dues

Section 1: Dues shall be \$5.00 per student once a year. Exceptions can be made for students demonstrating financial hardship when voted on by the executive officers.

Article V: Amending the Constitution and By-laws

Section 1: Amendments to the Constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member for the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required for amendments to occur.

Article VI: Meetings

Section 1: Meetings shall be held monthly, and can be called more frequently when needed, as decided by the executive officers.

Article VII: Committees

Section 1: When standing or special committees need to be formed for temporary purposes, all officers will vote on the name and nature of this committee and all members will vote on the person to lead this committee.
