ARTICLE I: NAME AND PURPOSE

This organization is called the "MSM Student Association" where MSM stands for Master of Science in Management.

The Association seeks to foster a sense of community and increase communication between MSM students and faculty. The Association organizes social, professional, and academic events, as well as other activities that benefit MSM students.

ARTICLE II: MEMBERSHIP AND DUES

Membership is open to all MSM students. Dues are \$ 25 per year.

ARTICLE III: OFFICERS

The Association will have a Board of Directors through the fall 1999 semester to help with the organization of the club. Towards the end of the academic year, officers will be elected by members. Thereafter, elections for officers will be held every spring semester. Term for officers will be 1 year. The official titles of the officers will be decided before the end of the spring 2000 semester.

ARTICLE IV: AMENDMENTS

This Constitution may be amended as appropriate pending the approval of majority of the club officers. The MSM office and the NCSU Student Organization Resource Student Center will be notified of any amendments. The most recent amendment will supercede all prior amendments and the original Constitution.

ARTICLE V: MEETINGS

Meetings and events will be organized by officers as needed.

ARTICLE VI: COMMITTEES

The officers will put committees in place as needed to assist with the operation of the club. The officers will appoint people to chair committees.


