Metal Appreciation Club Constitution

Metal Appreciation Club Constitution 8/23/07

Article | Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as the Metal Appreciation Club.

Section 2

The purposes of this club will be to support the local metal music scene, and to hopefully bring more prominent metal bands to perform in this area. This club will also be a good way for students who have similar tastes in music to meet each other, and to introduce them to new bands.

Article II Membership

Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in listening to, and supporting hard rock and all the different genres of metal.

Section 2

Anyone who expresses interest in metal/hard rock music, and who expresses an interest in supporting local metal bands will be admitted into the Metal Appreciation Club.

Article III Officers

Section 1

There shall be five elective officers in the club. There is no hierarchy of power, just different officers doing different jobs.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning in the fall semester of each year.

Article IV Dues

Section 1

There will be an optional due of \$10.00 to \$15.00 per semester for the new metal club t-shirt. (see Article VIII for more details)

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1

The club shall have optional meetings weekly, but a suggested meeting may be called. In that case each member will be sent an email stating why it has been called. The meeting schedule can be voted on to be changed at any meeting of the club.

Article VII Committees

Section 1

When committees are needed for an upcoming event volunteers from the club will form them. There will be no regular committees in the club, and the ones formed by an event will be dissolved after the event unless the club sees fit to keep it.

Article VIII Metal Band of the Semester

Section 1

At the beginning of every semester there will be a vote for the Metal Band of the Semester. That bands logo will appear on the new metal club t-shirt for that semester. Purchasing these t-shirts is completely optional, and we will take orders before buying them. We hope that these shirts will get other people interested in metal and hard rock.
