Constitution

October 3, 2003

Article I Name and Purpose

Section 1 This organization shall be know as NARAL Pro-Choice North Carolina on Campus.

Section 2 The purpose of this organization shall be to build a strong pro-choice presence on campus, to educate and encourage dialogue in the campus community on choice, reproductive rights, and other related issues.

Article II Membership

Section 1 Membership will be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in protecting choice in North Carolina and nationally through grassroots organizing.

Section 2 Selection of members will be accomplished through general recruiting. Interest forms and/or contact information shall be kept for each member.

Article III Officers

Section 1 The elective officers shall be President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Section 2 Officers shall be elected by the club members in April to serve a term of one year, beginning in May of that year.

Article IV Dues

Section 1 There will be no dues.

Article V Amending the Constitution and By-Laws

Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting and may be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member for the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 for the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1 Meetings shall be held as determined by an officer or by members in agreement with an officer. Regular monthly meetings may be decided at the beginning of each semester.

Article VII Committees

Section 1 The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
