

N.C. Skate Constitution

Article I—Name and Purpose

- Section 1** This organization shall be known as the N.C. Skate Organization.
Section 2 The purpose of this club shall be to promote the positive aspects of skateboarding, to increase campus awareness about skateboarding, to educate about skateboarding.

Article II—Membership

- Section 1** Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in learning about and/or participating in skateboarding.
Section 2

Article III—Officers

- Section 1** The officers of this organization shall consist of 5 full time students in good standing with N.C. University with duties and responsibilities including advertisement, organization of meetings and events, public relations, treasurer, and scribe.
Section 2 Officers must be full time students at N.C. State with a 2.5 GPA or better.
Section 3 Term of office shall be 2 semesters.
Section 4 Provisions for removal of an officer shall be a majority vote of the remaining officers. If there is an appeal, the rest of the club votes with a majority again decides the answer.

Article IV—Dues

- Section 1** 5 dollar dues will be collected at the beginning of the year.

Article V—Amending the Constitution and By-Laws

- Section 1** The constitution may be amended by a vote of two-thirds with a margin of at least 2 votes.

Article VI—Meetings

- Section 1** Regular meetings of this organization shall be held bi-monthly. Members will be notified by email by a designated officer.
Section 2 A quorum shall consist of 2/3rds of the voting members present at a meeting. Meetings shall go as follows:
1. Begin with a roll, summarize and discuss previous events and meetings.
2. Discuss active projects. This part includes any quorums.
3. A vote will be held on the quorum(s).
4. The end of the meeting will be an open discussion to generate ideas for the purpose and direction of the organization.

Article VII—Committees

- Section 1** Committees shall be formed as needed for projects or events. They will consist of volunteered or elected members.

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1: This organization shall be known as the NC SKATE CLUB.

Section 2: The purposes of this club shall be to promote a positive image of skateboarders, heighten public awareness of skateboarding, and to provide an organization on campus where individuals can express themselves through skateboarding.

Article II Membership

Section 1: Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in skateboarding.

Section 2: Membership will be approved after an introduction with other club members.

Article III Officers

Section 1: The elective officers of this club shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Section 2: The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning Fall 99.

Article IV Dues

Section 1: Dues for the club shall be \$5.00 per semester.

Article V Amending the Constitution and By-Laws

Section 1: Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1: The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.

Article VII Committees

Section 1: The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.

Article VIII Other

Section 1: For educational purposes, the club requests a yearly subscription to 411 Skateboarding Video Magazine.(please)
