Wrestling Club Constitution

Article I - Name and Purpose

Section 1: This organization shall be known as the Wrestling Club.

Section 2: The purpose of this club shall be for NCSU students to have the opportunity to wrestle and compete on a team.

Article II – Membership

Section 1: Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in wrestling.

Section 2: This club is not exclusive and will be open to all students. There will be no tryouts.

Article III - Officers

Section 1: The elected officers of this club shall be the President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary.

Section 2: The officers of this club shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning at the start of the Fall semester.

Article IV - Dues

Section 1: There will be no dues associated with this club.

Article V - Amending the Constitution and By-laws

Section 1: Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority vote of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI - Meetings

Section 1: The club shall meet as determined by club membership each semester.

Article VII - Committees

Section 1: The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.

NC State Wrestling Club Guiding Principles

Mission: The NC State Wrestling Club's mission is to provide an outlet for students interested in non-varsity wrestling activities. The Club seeks to support these wrestling enthusiasts in their particular goals - whether that is learning the sport, getting in a good workout, or preparing for national competition.

Goals: The goals of the Club are: (1) to increase Club membership by increasing awareness of the Club on campus, (2) provide for the practice and training of all levels of wrestlers, (3) provide for enthusiasts who wish to use wrestling to obtain a workout, (4) help wrestlers reach their individual tournament goals, and (5) forge and continually improve a Club "Team", which can compete with other schools and at tournaments, and which proudly represents NC State.

Leadership: The club elects its officers each spring for the following year. These officers serve for the fall and spring semesters unless they graduate in December, whereupon a replacement must be elected. The offices of President, Vice-President, and Treasurer are filled from popular vote by the eligible members of the Club.
