

Pack Bhangra Constitution

Article I – Name and Purpose

- Section 1** This organization shall be known as the NC State Bhangra Pack
Section 2 The purpose of this club shall be to spread awareness of Indian Bhangra music and dance.

Article II – Membership

- Section 1** Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in Bhangra dancing.
Section 2 Membership will be dictated by team tryouts once a year.

Article III – Officers

- Section 1** The officers of this organization shall consist of: 4 officers, president, vice-president, treasurer, and secretary. The president's duty is to oversee all team activities and competitions. The vice-president is to assist the president in his/her duties and take over the president's duties in case the president cannot attend to them. The treasurer's duty is to keep track of all financial issues. The secretary is to keep a record of all meeting discussions and inform team members of upcoming team events.
Section 2 In order to become an officer, a year of experience on the Bhangra Pack is required.
Section 3 Each officer shall hold the position for the duration of a school year.
Section 4 An officer can be requested to be removed if he/she is not keeping up with the required duties. In order for an officer to be removed, a majority of the officers needs to agree on the removal.

Article IV – Dues

- Section 1** The dues shall be paid as soon as the individual is selected to be on the team. The dues will be \$5.00 for the entire year.

Article V – Amending the Constitution and By-Laws

- Section 1** The constitution may be amended by a vote of a majority of the team. Any amendments must be written by the officers, but the non-officers may have input.

Article VI – Meetings

- Section 1** Regular meetings of this organization shall be held monthly. The secretary will be responsible for notifying members of upcoming meetings by email.
